


Welcome to St Barnabas Church

FINANCE SUMMARY (as at 15 May)

Total Income \$ 77,361
Total Expenses -62,312
Net Surplus (Deficit) 15,432
Offertory & Donation Income \$ 62,347

Note: The offertory and donation income above includes \$16,125 given in response to our special financial appeal during March-April, so the projected surplus for the full year is likely to be considerably less than the current surplus. Nevertheless, this is an encouraging result, in large part the result of the generous response of God's people to the appeal, for which we give thanks to God. We will provide a budget projection for the year in a future edition of the weekly bulletin.
